Subject : High-capacity filter for cigarettes


Gentlemen :

It is based on a new principle (patent pending) and will eliminate noxious components to a very high degree without impairing the taste. Messrs. Reemtsma of this country are already experimenting with the new material which is giving the best protection to cigarette smokers obtainable today.
