Dear Senator Dole:

On behalf of the nearly 25,000 American Cancer Society volunteers in the state of Kansas, I am writing to request your support for FDA regulation of tobacco products.

For decades, tobacco has existed outside accepted regulatory channels. While manufacturers of virtually every other consumer product must adhere to sensible rules governing manufacture and marketing, tobacco manufacturers are under no such restrictions. Thus smokers have no idea what is in the cigarettes they smoke. This is particularly important because tobacco marketing is designed to entice young people of both genders and all races to begin smoking.

Failure to act decisively to control tobacco use will allow millions of our young people to become addicted to cigarettes and compromise the very health we are responsible for protecting. Please help us in our efforts by supporting FDA regulation of tobacco products.
