**CONFIDENTIAL:**  
**MINNESOTA TOBACCO LITIGATION**

THE FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION denied a complaint filed by Paul Loveday, chairman of the Calif. anti-smoking group which backed Prop. 10. Loveday contended that anti-Prop. 10 commercials, sponsored by Californians Against Regulatory Excess (CARE), should have been identified as sponsored by the tobacco industry.

"Although there was uncontroverted evidence that four major tobacco companies contributed 99 percent of CARE's funding...there was no evidence to show that these companies exercised editorial control," said the FCC news release.
