## Bartlett bans smoking in public buildings

Bartlett's Mayor and Board of Aldermen Tuesday night banned smoking in public buildings.

The no-smoking ordinance, which was approved on third and final reading, drew no opposition from the audi-

ence. It establishes fines for violators, including proprietors failing to post no-smoking signs and those smoking in forbidden areas.

The ordinance gives restaurants seat-

ing more than 50 the option of providing no-smoking sections or making the entire restaurant nonsmoking.

It allows owners of stores to provide smoking and nonsmoking sections for employees away from shopping areas.
