MONTPELIER — State's new drunken driving law — 1 of USA's toughest — takes effect July 1. Gov. Shelley reminded residents. Among changes, blood alcohol level drops to .08% from .10%; 3rd DUI conviction would be felony; drivers under 18 with at least .02% blood alcohol will face civil penalties. Tobacco producers launched campaign to comply with new state law barring cigarette sales to youths under 18. Law — effective July 1 — bans cigarette machines from areas frequented by youths. Some legislators say they're skeptical because ads still target young.
