Dear Dr. Bowers:

Upon the recommendation of the Scientific Advisory Board to the Tobacco Industry Research Committee, a grant has been approved in the amount of \$4,000.00 for continuing your research project, which became active on July 1, 1957 through a second calendar year. The new grant will become effective on the anniversary date, unless we receive other instructions meanwhile. Our check will be forwarded to the business office of your institution on or about that date.

According to our understanding, this present grant will enable you to complete the program substantially as outlined in your application dated April 1, 1957. Hence this grant is regarded as the terminal one for this project. New applications may, of course, be filed with the Board in the future for consideration on the same basis as those from other qualified scientific laboratories and in the light of the situation which may then exist in the overall program.

An accounting for expenditures made during the project year ending June 30, 1958 will be appreciated at the earliest convenience of the business office following the end of the project year. Any uncommitted balance remaining as of that date may be retained for the purposes of the project during 1958-'59 and a final adjustment made following termination of the work.

We are pleased that this continuation of support is possible and trust that it will provide a fruitful extension of the studies underway.
